Should you install solar panels on your farm?

While just installing solar panels on your farm can be beneficial enough to justify the cost, some farmers use the protection from the sun provided by the panels to help grow crops that thrive in the shade. This process is called agrivoltaics.

Should farmers build solar panels on agricultural land?

But thanks to years of research, farmers and developers have learned to coordinate their efforts to benefit both parties. It may involve building solar panel arrays about 8 feet off the ground to allow space for crop growth and farm equipment. As of the end of 2022, less than 2% of solar energy projects are on agricultural land.

Can a ground-mounted solar panel be installed on a farm?

Depending on the lease terms, ground-mounted solar may or may not be allowed on the site. If it is allowed and current farming operations are suitable for a ground-mounted solar PV array or if unused land exists, ground-mounted solar PV may be an option. How can I reduce soil compaction when installing ground-mounted solar panels?

How much does it cost to build a solar farm?

At an average price of \$1.06 per watt, a 5 MW project would represent a \$5.3 million investment, but a 100 MW project can exceed \$100 million. You can classify solar farms based on the purpose of the project: Utility-scale solar farms are built with the intention of selling electricity.

Is agrivoltaics more expensive than traditional solar development?

Agrivoltaics is not always more expensive than traditional solar development, but certain configurations can be more complex for planning and permitting. A successful agrivoltaics project requires two or more groups who often have very different priorities--the farmer or land manager and the solar developer--to find a solution that works for both.

Today's premium monocrystalline solar panels typically cost between \$1 and \$1.50 per Watt, putting the price of a single 400-watt solar panel between \$400 and \$600, depending on how you buy it. Less efficient polycrystalline panels ...
