Should you cat-proof your balcony?

If you and your cat live in a property that is higher than two stories, then you need to think about cat-proofing your balcony. Unfortunately, falls aren't the only problem. If you will be leaving your cat on your balcony, then you will need to give them a safe environment (beyond just a railing).

How do I Keep my Cat safe on a balcony?

Especially if you live in a high-rise building, you'll want to ensure your cat cannot escape the balcony area. Having a fully screened-in balcony is ideal. Or, you can put up netting or fencing to enclose your outdoor space. If you're so inclined and handy with tools, you can even build your kitty their very own "catio" outdoors!
