Can solar panels be installed on a commercial roof?

Should you install solar panels on an old roof?

Roof condition, location, and age are key considerations when installing solar panels. Your roof's condition--new, old, leaky--impacts installation choices. "Be cautious about putting brand new solar panels on an older roof," Helland warns. Installing panels over an aging or degraded roof could accelerate existing roof problems.

Can you install solar panels on a flat roof?

Ballast systems are simply a weighted racking setup that holds solar panels in place. If you need to drill into your flat roof to install solar panels, don't worry-- your solar installer will ensure that the holes they drill are as small as possible and sealed correctly to avoid roof damage or leaking. Can you install solar panels on wooden roofs?

How long do solar panels last on a roof?

Solar panels have a 25-30-year lifespan and are unlikely to need a new roof during this time. However, it is recommended to install them on roofs that are not more than 15 years old. Installing new roofs before putting solar panels on your roof is ideal, as your roof must be in good condition to support PV panels.

Can solar panels be installed on wood shake roofs?

Wood shake roofs are not suitable for solar panel installation as they are potential fire hazards and present safety issues. Roofing materials made from slate tiles and clay aren't suitable for solar panel installation due to their fragility, making it challenging for contractors to mount them. Some jurisdictions won't permit solar panel installation on wood shake roofs.

Will a shade near my roof affect my solar panel?

Will a shade near your roof affect the performance of your solar panels? Consult a solar panel contractor for advice. The orientation of your PV panel significantly influences its production capacity. In general, south-facing panels (180 degrees true orientation) work more effectively.
