



# Is it okay to tape the seams of photovoltaic panels

How to seal between solar panels using a silicone sealant?

Below is a step-by-step procedure of how to seal between solar panels using a silicone sealant: Clean the surface to get rid of tape or any other material before starting the sealing process. Add the silicone sealant at the point where the glass meets with the frame or whichever edge protection is present.

How long does VHB tape last on solar panels?

I've had the gray VHB tape with red liner on my Solar panels for 4 years. When you prep really well, that stuff sticks. My flexible panels failed both, so I had to get that tape off. Really really hard to get removed. Took me two days of grinding and repainting the roof.

What should I do before reinstalling solar panels?

Before reinstalling solar panels, ensure you remove any water on the inner side. Be careful not to tilt the panels during the sealing process. If water accumulates on these panels and drips to the inside, it can cause a short circuit. Use adhesive tape or silicone tape to hold the panels and everything else in place when reinstalling.
