How is a solar energy project approved?

The approval process for a solar energy project involves several basic steps. First, a permit application is submitted for review by a local permitting agency, known as the "enforcing agency." Typically, the contractor installing the solar energy system will submit the permit on behalf of the building owner.

What should be included in a solar PV installation checklist?

The checklist does not need to take the exact form of this template, but it should include the basic information an installer, developer, or property owner would need to know in order to receive approval for the installation of a residential solar PV system.

How do I install a solar PV system?

Components that are certified and tested for solar PV installations must be installed in accordance with the NEC and the manufacturer's installation instructions. Most residential solar PV systems are very simple from an electrical standpoint, and they can be designed by a solar or electrical contractor.

Do you need a roof access point for a solar PV system?

Solar installations must also allow for fire department smoke ventilation operations. The International Building, Residential, and Fire Codes outline the requirements for a roof access point and clear access points along the roof. The installation of solar PV systems may be subject to additional provisions adopted by the local enforcing agency.

Can a rooftop solar PV system be installed on a building?

The vast majority of rooftop solar PV systems are installed on existing structures. Even though very few of these buildings were constructed specifically for installing solar equipment, many of them are well suited for PV systems.

Do I need to meter a photovoltaic system?

It is assumed that aluminum framed photovoltaic (PV) panels mounted on a "post" and rail mounting system, the most common in the industry today, will be installed by the homeowner. While metering the system is encouraged, the specification does not address system wiring elements for associated system sensors or monitoring equipment.
