



Photovoltaic grid-connected inverter wiring tutorial

What is a grid connected PV system?

Grid connected PV systems always have a connection to the public electricity grid via a suitable inverter because a photovoltaic panel or array (multiple PV panels) only deliver DC power. As well as the solar panels, the additional components that make up a grid connected PV system compared to a stand alone PV system are:

How do I design a PV Grid connect system?

The document provides the minimum knowledge required when designing a PV Grid connect system. The actual design criteria could include: specifying a specific size (in kWp) for an array; available budget; available roof space; wanting to zero their annual electrical usage or a number of other specific customer related criteria.

How do you ground a solar inverter?

System Grounding - System grounding requires taking one conductor from a two-wire system and connecting it to ground. In a DC system, this means bonding the negative conductor to ground at one single point in the system. This must be accomplished inside the inverter, not at the PV array.

Do I need a user manual for a grid-connected PV system?

All complex systems require a user manual for the customer. Grid-connected PV systems are no different. The documentation for system installation that shall be provided shall include: The following pages contain example test records that may be used as part of the system commissioning.

What is a PV inverter manual?

The inverter is grid-connected, transformer-less, robust and of high conversion efficiency. This manual contains information about the inverter, which will provide guidelines on connecting the inverter into the PV power system and how to operate the inverter. The manual cannot include all information about the PV system.

How do I connect a grid-tied solar panel system?

Always refer to the NEC code in effect or consult a licensed electrician for safety and accuracy. There are two basic approaches to connecting a grid-tied solar panel system, as shown in the wiring diagrams below. The most common is a "LOAD SIDE" connection, made AFTER the main breaker.
