Are rooftop solar panels a fire risk?

Although fires from rooftop PV systems are incredibly rare, some building owners may have concerns, especially after hearing about a high-profile case in 2018 when seven of Walmart's rooftop solar systems caught fire. Because solar panels have live wires, there is always going to be some level of fire risk--just like with any electrical device.

Did solar panels catch fire?

Seven of 240 stores in which solar panels were installed on roofs caught fire. Resulting in multiply fires across the US Systematic negligence in operating, installing and maintaining the solar system by the producer company Ichihara, Japan 2019 (NEWS)

Is commercial-grade rooftop solar a fire risk?

Commercial-grade rooftop solar is still a relatively new field with solar jobs outpacing the overall job growth rate in the U.S. by 5x over the past decade. Incomplete or inconsistent training is understandably associated with this type of rapid industry expansion and is one of the leading causes of fire risks on commercial rooftops.

Are rooftop PV installations a fire hazard?

Dutch research institute TNO has released a series of guidelines to reduce fire hazards in rooftop PV installations. The study follows a series of fire accidents that occurred between 2018 and 2020 in the Netherlands, for which the main causes were identified. Connectors and junction boxes were pointed out as a frequent source of fire accidents.
