Do photovoltaic materials have a practical conversion performance based on spectral measurements?

By average photon energy, this paper assessed the practical conversion performance of ten types of photovoltaic materials based on the spectral measurements of Beijing and Changsha, China. Photon energy utilization efficiency was proposed to assess the practical conversion performance of photovoltaic materials at the same aperture area.

How does  $\eta_{\text{PEU}}$  affect the energy conversion performance of PV materials?

As the  $\eta_{\text{PEU}}$  increases, the energy conversion performance of PV materials with the same aperture also increases. Moreover, the weighted photon energy utilization efficiency ( $\eta_{\text{WPEU}}$ ) was proposed to assess the successional energy conversion performance of PV materials with the dynamic spectral distribution.  $\eta_{\text{WPEU}}$  is expressed by Eq.

How can photovoltaic technology improve energy conversion efficiencies?

Technologically, the main challenge for the photovoltaic industry is improving PV module energy conversion efficiencies. Therefore, a variety of techniques have been tested, applied and deployed on PV and PV/T systems. Combined methods have also been a crucial impact toward efficiency improvement endeavors.

What is the conversion efficiency of polymer solar panels?

The conversion efficiency higher than 14.69 % was obtained for average yearly PV panel temperature close to 22 °C. An experimentation process and a viability analysis were conducted by about the water evaporation and algal development by installing large-surface semi-transparent polymer solar cells.

What is the photoelectric conversion rate of a photovoltaic cell?

The photoelectric conversion rate of the photovoltaic cell is the ratio of the output power of the photovoltaic cell to the total solar radiation power radiated on the surface of the photovoltaic cell:
