BEIJING, July 11 (Reuters) - China Southern Power Grid saw power demand soar to a record 226 gigawatts (GW) on Monday, according to a post on the grid company's official Weibo account on Tuesday.

What is China's State Grid?

China's State Grid, one of the country's two grid operators, proposed the technology to the government in 2004 to connect the country's hydro and coal power stations with the economic hubs that gobbled electricity hundreds of miles away.

Will a digital power grid help China achieve a carbon peak?

A digital power grid will better facilitate the consumption of power increasingly produced by clean energy while further facilitating China's ambition to achieve a carbon peak by 2030 and carbon neutrality by 2060, he said.
