Why is my generator not running?

Your generator was running fine, but now it shuts off and won't stay running. A generator starts and then dies due to an empty fuel tank, plugged fuel filter, dirty carburetor, clogged fuel line, bad gas cap, dirty spark plug, faulty ignition coil, low engine oil level, or old gas.

Why is my Generac generator not starting?

If the generator turns over and just won't start, look for issues that may cause a fuel, air, or spark restriction. This may be a plugged fuel filter, clogged fuel lines, dirty carburetor, bad fuel tank vent, bad spark plug, or faulty ignition coil. What if a generator won't start?

Spark ignites the fuel and air mixture to start the engine. If your generator won't turn over, check the starter recoil on a manual start generator or the battery, starter solenoid, and wiring on an electric start generator. Reasons a Generator Won't Start: Solved! Fill with fresh fuel.

What causes a generator to die?

Other common reasons for a generator dying are fuel and airflow restrictions. Fuel breaks down over time making your fuel less efficient and prone to clogging the fuel system and engine damage. Drain the fuel tank and fill it with fresh fuel. Use a fuel additive like Sea Foam to stabilize the fuel and assist with cleaning the fuel system.

Why isn't my generator working?

If the generator doesn't start and the fuel is flowing, return the pipe to the intake and try starting the generator again. If not, close the fuel valve and clean it before trying again.

What are the most common generator problems?

The most common generator problems are: Take caution when performing repairs. Always remove the spark plug wire and wait for the engine to cool.
