How much does it cost to remove solar panels from a roof?

On average, the cost to remove solar panels from a roof in 2024 is \$300 to \$1,000 per panel. The exact price for your home solar panel removal depends on the number of solar panels, whether you lease vs. own, and the damage the solar panels have incurred over the years.

Can solar panels be removed from a roof?

Should I remove or reinstall my solar panels?

Removing and reinstalling your panels is one of those potential costs. With solar panel warranties of 25 to 30 years and a usable lifespan of well over 30 years, it is possible that you will need to remove the panels to patch a portion of your roof or install an entirely new roof.

When should you remove solar panels?

While roof repairs and replacements are among the most common situations for solar panel removal, there are several other scenarios where removing solar panels becomes necessary or beneficial: Upgrading your system: As technology advances, you might decide to upgrade to more efficient panels, requiring the removal of your existing system.

Do you need a permit to remove solar panels?

Permit regulations: Some localities require permits for solar panel removal, which can increase expenses and limit the available contractors with the appropriate license to apply for the permit. Lease vs. own: If you leased the solar panel system, the solar developer you worked with for the installation removes the panels.

Do solar panels need to be removed before a lease expires?

If you are leasing the solar panels, be aware that you might be charged a penalty for removing the panels before the end of your contract. A lease is usually around 25 years, according to LandGate Resources. Whether the lease is up or it is terminated early, the solar developer is responsible for doing the actual removal.
