Why do we need a solar inverter?

As PV solar installations continues to grow rapidly over the last decade, the need for solar inverter with high efficiency, improved power density and higher power handling capabilities continues to scale up.

Do solar power converters need isolation?

In a solar power converter, high-voltage and low-voltage circuits co-exist. Isolations are required between the high-voltage and low-voltage circuits for both functional and safety purposes. Fundamental isolation concepts and terminology are presented in references [3-4]. Digital isolators can be used to address the isolation requirements.

Should a PV inverter be a DC isolator?

My PV (string) inverter came with instructions always to operate the a.c. side isolation first - I understand that the theory was that with the inverter shut down no current was drawn through the d.c. side even though the d.c. voltage was still present - making it then safer to operate the d.c. isolator.

Do you need a solar isolator switch?

In a PV system, it's usually necessary to have a switch that can isolate the PV panels from the system --or the inverter from the grid and loads. This is mainly done using a solar isolator switch. This switch allows you easily (and safely) turn off your solar circuits whenever necessary.

Why is galvanic isolation important in grid-connected photovoltaic microinverters?

Galvanic isolation in grid-connected photovoltaic (PV) microinverters is a very important feature concerning power quality and safety issues. However, high-frequency transformers and high switching losses degrade the efficiency of the isolated types of microinverters.

Why do we use isolated microinverters?

Isolated microinverters provide high-quality power by reducing the harmonics in the injected grid current. The galvanic isolation provided by high-frequency transformers also aids in ground fault protection. Therefore, most grid standards for distributed power generation systems are fulfilled by isolated microinverters.
